Code of Conduct for Volunteers

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All volunteers must:

- Consider the well-being and safety of players before the development of performance
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with players, based on mutual trust and respect
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part
- Promote the positive aspects of hockey and Lansdown Hockey Club (e.g. fair play)
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and Lansdown Hockey Club
- Where applicable hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover
- Never exert undue influence over players to obtain personal benefit or reward
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances

If a volunteer does not adhere to the code of conduct:

- They will be politely asked to abstain from any infringement of the codes of conduct. Should a volunteer continue to violate the codes of conduct on a number of occasions, Lansdown Hockey Club will assess the violation taking necessary action
