Code of Conduct for Parents/Carer/Spectator

Lansdown Hockey Club encourages parents/carer/spectators to take an active interest in their child's development within hockey and ask that every parent, carer or spectator observe the following:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in hockey
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Praise and encourage your child as much as possible
- Publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them to understand that the enjoyment of sport and fair play are more important than winning
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Encourage the wearing and correct use of hockey equipment and protective clothing
- Be courteous to other parents, players, coaches and umpires at all times
- Encourage your child to arrive promptly to training and matches and always notify your coach or captain if you cannot make a session or match.
- When your child arrives to a match or training always make sure you accompany your child to the Astro turf to make sure there is a responsible adult on site at the venue.
